### 2.1 Safe Work Practices

## 2.2 Responsibilities

- **Project Managers / Engineers:** Ensure implementation of EHS controls on site.
- **Workers / Labour:** Follow all safety rules and report unsafe conditions.

## 2.3 Site Safety Protocols

- Daily site toolbox talks.
- Weekly safety audits and checklists.
- Emergency exit marking and fire prevention systems.
- Safety monitoring during high-risk activities (cutting, grinding, electrical work, height work, welding, material shifting).

## 2.4 Medical & Occupational Health

- First-aid kits on every site.
- Medical checkups for workers as required.
- Hydration and rest arrangements in extreme weather.

## 3.1 Pollution Control

- Control noise, dust, and emissions through approved equipment and methods.
- Cover materials, use water sprinkling, and maintain machinery.

## 3.2 Waste Management

- Segregate waste (wood, metal, debris, plastic).
- Follow proper disposal as per environmental and municipal guidelines.
- Minimize wastage through accurate cutting, reuse, recycling.

## 3.3 Energy & Resource Conservation

- Use LED lighting, efficient machines, and equipment.
  - Optimize water usage.
  - Promote reusable packaging and sustainable materials.

- Emergency response team appointed for each project.

  - Root cause analysis (RCA) conducted.
  - Corrective and preventive actions (CAPA) implemented.

  - Specialized training for:
    - Electrical safety
    - Working at height
    - Fire safety
    - Lifting/Material handling

- Daily safety checklists
  - Site inspection reports
  - Safety sign-off sheets
  - Environmental checklists
  - Record of PPE issuance
  - Monthly internal audits and management reviews
